BTC League Rules and Regulations

Updated 9/25

BTC leagues teams accommodate adult players in a friendly and competitive format.

- 1. The board will designate one of its members to serve as League Coordinator.
- 2. Members interested in creating a league team must submit a written request to the BTC League Coordinator or designee before requesting a league team through the USTA league coordinator. The BTC League Coordinator and BTC Club Director will work together to balance demands on the facility and interest expressed in captaining from all parties before approving or denying league requests.
- 3. Upon receiving approval from BTC League Coordinator, league team must be approved through USTA league coordinator Randie Lettington and Karol Wong.
- 4. Captains are required to submit a complete roster of players prior to the start of the season and notify the club of any roster changes during the season. Every player on the team must be a member of Balboa Tennis Club.
- 5. Each BTC team is required to pay a league fee to BTC prior to the start of the season. The cost is \$50 per team.
- 6. Complete home match schedule should be submitted to the Club Director as soon as they become available.
- 7. Any misuse of BTC league rules, lack of player accountability or illegal usage of players not registered with BTC will result in being banned for a year from participating on a BTC league team.
- 6. Sportsmanship by all players representing BTC is expected and appreciated.
- 8. Any changes in team schedule due to rain should be coordinated through Club Director.
- 9. Members who captain 4 teams per year will receive a complimentary membership for the following year at Balboa Tennis Club.

- 10. All league teams will usually rotate between courts 19-24, unless there is another event booked at the Club.
- 11. No more than 6 courts will be assigned at one time for league play unless there are unusual scheduling circumstances.
- 12. Members will be limited to captaining only *one* team per season. An exception to this rule may be made if the member wishes to serve as captain of a league team for which no other member has expressed interest in serving as captain.
- 13. Returning captains who have followed through with the rules and have shown consistency will be given priority to captain the following season.
